

## Image Metadata (Baby Steps)

Using exiftool, we can extract the "hidden" information in the "Snakes are Awesome" image.

The information is "hidden" as image **metadata**, which is stored in specific locations in a file.

### **Steganography in Text**

- Hide text within another text using markers (ex. bold words, words after commas, the next word every N characters)
- Translate (letters, words) into words, numbers, or phrases (ex. "A" becomes "the nefarious polyglot")
- Translate letters, words into white space
- Misrepresent the text (ex. spam, PGP)




